

Project Overview

The I-35 at Williams Drive project includes the construction of a new Williams Drive bridge over I-35 to accommodate a diverging diamond interchange (DDI), northbound and southbound intersection bypass lanes under the Williams Drive bridge, extension of the northbound I-35 frontage road from Williams Drive to the Lakeway Drive exit (#264), improvements to the existing southbound I-35 frontage road, the Austin Avenue intersection at Williams Drive, and bicycle and pedestrian paths along the frontage road.

Construction Phases

Work on this improvement project will take place in three phases:

- **Phase I:** Improve the Austin Avenue intersection at Williams Drive, construct the new northbound I-35 frontage road between Williams Drive and Lakeway Drive, widen the northbound and southbound I-35 frontage roads and construct ramps.
- **Phase II:** Reconstruct the Williams Drive bridge over I-35 for DDI and construct northbound and southbound I-35 bypass lanes.
- **Phase III:** Switch traffic to the new DDI traffic pattern and construct shared-use paths along the I-35 frontage roads.



Details

The construction cost for the 2.6-mile project is \$61.7 million. Construction was funded by Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) and TxDOT. Construction start is October 2020 and is expected to be complete in mid-2023, weather permitting. The contractor for the project is J.D. Abrams L.P.
