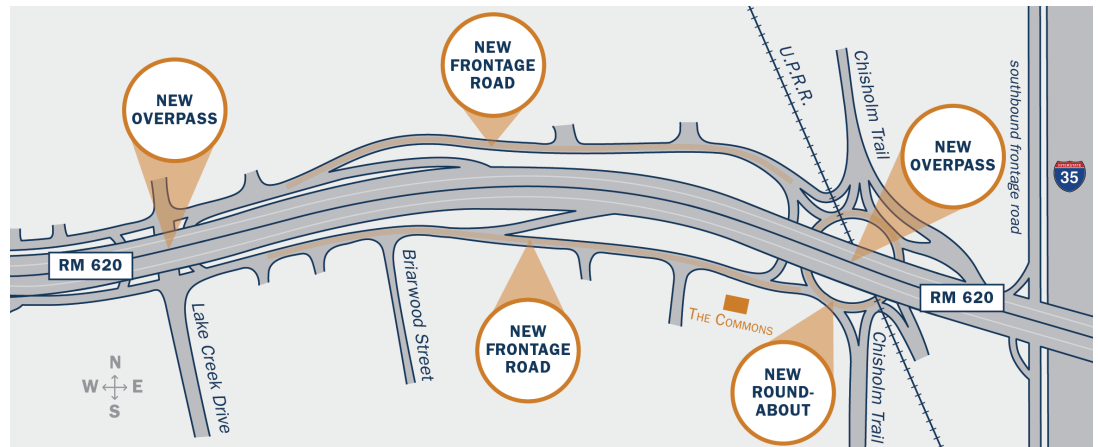


RM 620 Roundabout Project (I-35 to Deep Wood Drive) Construction Information



Why the improvements are needed

RM 620 from I-35 to Deep Wood Drive has a high volume of traffic and congestion. By elevating the roadway over the Union Pacific Railroad tracks and Lake Creek Drive and adding new frontage roads, travel times could be reduced.



Project details

Adding overpasses at Chisholm Trail and Lake Creek Drive, constructing a roundabout at RM 620 and Chisholm Trail beneath the new overpass, widening lanes, adding frontage roads and improving bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.

Construction highlights

- Construct eastbound and westbound frontage roads
- Construct overpasses at Chisholm Trail and Lake Creek Drive
- Widen lanes along RM 620 and build bicycle and pedestrian accommodations
- Construct roundabout at RM 620 and Chisholm Trail

Timeline

Work on the project begins in March 2020 and is expected to be complete by late 2022, weather permitting.

Project cost

\$27.4 million (TxDOT, City of Round Rock and Williamson County)
