I-35 from Rundberg Lane to US 290 East CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION





Project Overview

The I-35 from Rundberg Lane to US 290 East project addresses mobility on one of the most congested highways in Texas. I-35 serves as the backbone of the local, regional, and national transportation network. Lack of mobility on I-35 threatens the economic livelihood of our city and state.

The project will improve mobility, safety, and connectivity for all modes of transportation along and across I-35. Work includes

- Adding three flyovers at the I-35/US 183 interchange
 - I-35 southbound to US 183 southbound
 - o US 183 northbound to I-35 northbound
 - o I-35 southbound to US 183 northbound
- Improving the existing I-35 northbound to US 183 northbound flyover
- Rebuilding St. Johns Avenue bridge
- Constructing new frontage road U-turns in both directions at St. John's Avenue
- Constructing new intersection bypass lanes under the St. Johns bridge in both directions
- Adding extended entrance/exit lanes
- Reconfiguring and improving ramps and shoulders
- Improving bicycle and pedestrian sidewalks and paths



Details

The 2.7 mile project's construction cost is \$124.2 million. Construction is partially funded by Texas Clear Lanes, TxDOT's Congestion Relief Initiative. Construction started in January 2018 and is expected to be complete mid 2021, weather permitting. The contractor is JD Abrams, Inc.
