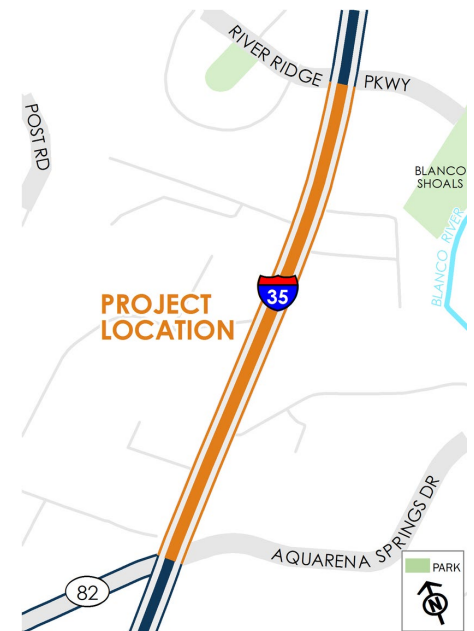
Project Overview

Lack of mobility on I-35 threatens the economic livelihood of Texas. With nearly 152,000 vehicles traveling on I-35 in Hays County each day, the I-35 from south of Loop 82 to north of River Ridge Parkway project will improve mobility, safety and connectivity for all modes of transportation along I-35. Work includes relocating the existing northbound I-35 entrance ramp, constructing a new northbound exit ramp, reconstructing the northbound frontage road, and adding a new extended entrance/exit lane.

Construction Phases

Work on this project will take place in five phases:

- **Phase I:** Install temporary signage and drainage along the northbound I-35 frontage road.
- **Phase II:** Install sound and retaining walls, reconstruct the northbound I-35 mainlanes and frontage road, and begin construction on entrance and exit ramps.
- **Phase III:** Construct the northbound I-35 entrance and exit ramps.
- **Phase IV:** Install high-mast lighting and reconstruct intersections at Crepe Myrtle Street and Hackberry Street.
- **Phase V:** Perform final paving, striping and signage for the entire project.



Details

This \$14 million project is funded by CAMPO and TxDOT. Construction is anticipated to begin January 2021 and is expected to be complete in late 2022, weather permitting. The contractor for the project is Hunter Industries, Ltd.
